AIMEE MELTON WINS DISTRICT 7 PRIMARY

Councilmember Melton carries District 7 with 68 percent: clear choice of liberal vs. conservative for general election voters.

Omaha, Nebraska- This evening, Omaha City Councilmember **Aimee Melton** released a statement on her victory in the City Council District 7 Primary:

"I'm honored by the vote of confidence from the voters. When I ran four years ago, the city budget was in deficit even after steep tax hikes, crime had spiked, and union contracts were breaking the city. Our police force was at a historic low. In every case, we've turned that around: two tax cuts, conservative spending, and more police officers with new technology on our streets.
